Class Enrollment: Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Registrations will be held online, visit calexicoca.myrec.com to create an account and register. Recreation will not be accepted during class. Classes not meeting their minimum enrollment will be cancelled.

Registration Fees: Program fees are listed throughout the program guide. All fees are due at the time of registration. Fees will not be prorated for missed classes.

Class Attendance and punctuality: Attendance is limited to individuals enrolled in the program. No make-up classes will be offered. It is essential to be on time. If a participant is late to class, they will need to check with the office to determine if they can join the course as long as the class is in the warm-up portion of the class. If a class has commenced the skill portion of the class, the participant will be asked to attend the next scheduled class.

Liability waiver: To register, you will need to agree to the liability waiver included in the registration packet.


